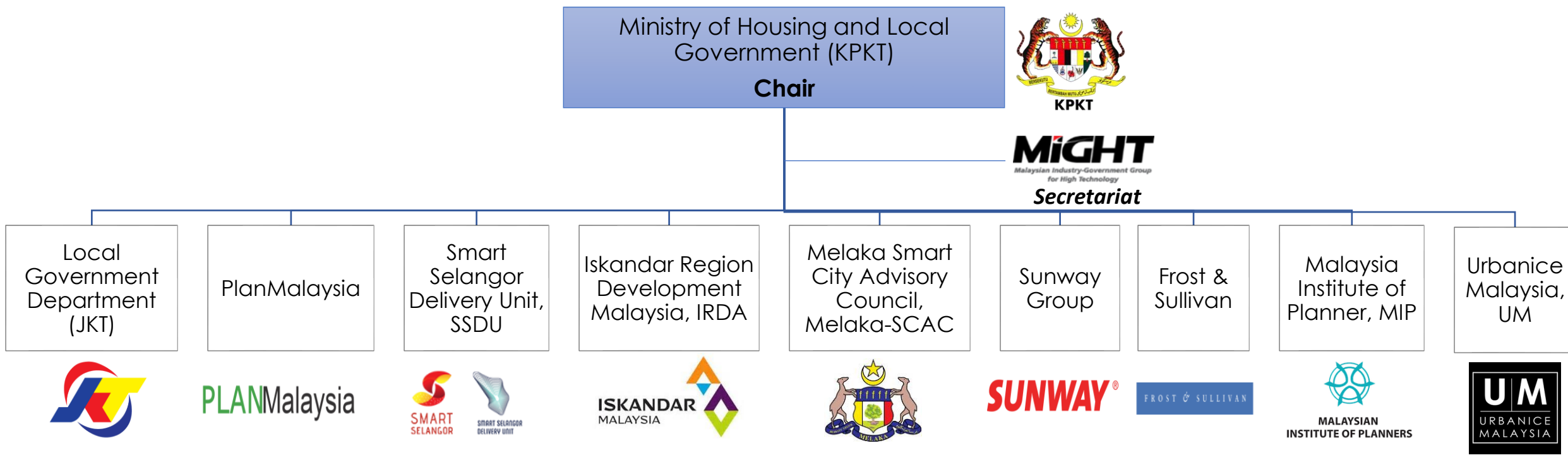
PROJECT SCOPE

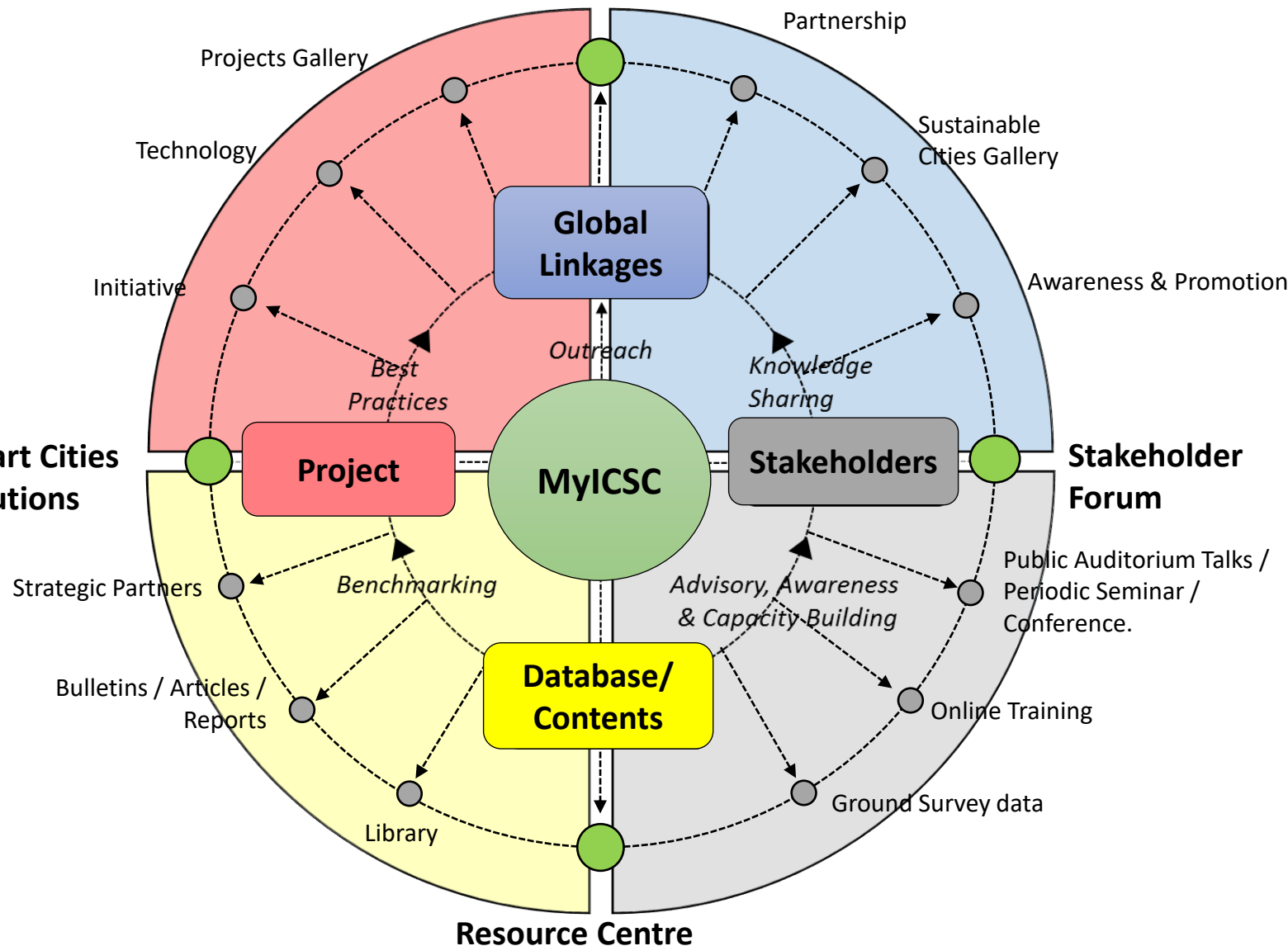
